### ONE-PAGER - What is it?

#### ONE-PAGER – What should be included?

Title or work and author's name (spelled correctly)
Border that reflects the text as a whole (consider words, pictures, symbols)
Dominant image/illustration that represents the text as a whole
ONE dominant word that expresses the tone and mood of the text (Consider how the text "feels")
(2) Quotes: Include two meaningful and notable quotes. Write them down anywhere on your page neatly. Use different colors and/or style of writing to individualize them.
Visual Images: Draw (3) or more separate visual images (characters, action, symbol, etc.) that represent the text.

Theme: A thematic statement for the text. (A theme is a complete sentence with a universal message. It is NOT one word)
