

The Sky Tree (p. 35) POV Change

The Huron creation myth, “The Sky Tree”, is told from 3rd person objective point of view. This is the “fly on the wall” perspective where the reader is allowed access to all of the action in the story but none of the individual thoughts of the characters.

Now you will **rewrite the story from a different perspective**. Rewrite means to paraphrase, not copy the story sentence by sentence.

You can write as the old chief, as one of the animals, as one of the villagers, or anything that makes sense to the story. You can even keep the story in 3rd person, but change it from objective to limited or omniscient. Be creative!!! Consider the thoughts and feelings of the characters in the story in your retelling.
